- 1. The rapid increase of divorce, with the undermining of the sanctity of the home, which is the basis of society.
- 2. Higher and higher taxes and the spending of public money in a frivolous and reckless way.
- 3. The mad craze for pleasure; sports becoming every year more brutal, hence, more and more exciting.
- 4. The building of gigantic armaments, when the real enemy was within—the decadence of the people.
- 5. The decay of religion— faith fading into mere form. Losing touch with life, and becoming indifferent to guidance.

Think carefully about these five causes for the fall of a great nation. Perhaps it is much later than we think. Solomon said in Proverbs 14:34, "Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people."
